“Proverbs To Ponder”

Regardless of our age, we are never too old to learn new things, nor to be reminded of things we once knew. Let us therefore, take a moment to ponder some of the Holy Spirit's proverbs, as penned by Solomon (II Pet. 1:20-21). May these wise words help us to make the right decisions daily.

1. **“If sinners entice you, do not consent” (Prov. 1:10).** The worst thing we can do is follow those who are wicked into their wickedness. Let us be interested in what God wants, and follow Him only! (Eph. 5:1; Col. 3:17)

2. **“Be not wise in your own eyes: fear the LORD, and turn away from evil” (Prov. 3:7).** Arrogance and pride will bring us down quickly (Prov. 14:12). “Self” is not the correct standard for life (Jer. 10:23)! Therefore, let us fear God and keep His commandments every day (Ecc. 12:13).

3. **“Keep your heart with all vigilance; for from it flow the springs of life” (Prov. 4:23).** If we guard, or watch our heart, we will be on our way to controlling our actions, and speech. Our speech and actions (good or bad) are formed in the heart (Matt. 15:17-19; Phil. 4:8).
